Dear Chairs and Ranking Members:

In accordance with 15 U.S.C. § 638b(c), this letter transmits the U.S. Department of Commerce Office of Inspector General's (OIG's) report of data and information regarding cases related to the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program for fiscal year (FY) 2024.

During FY 2024, OIG did not open or close any investigations relating to SBIR award recipients. Three investigative actions opened during previous reporting periods remain in an open investigative status.

OIG's estimated FY 2024 expenditures involving SBIR program investigations to date were \$7,439; no funds were recovered or saved as a result of OIG's SBIR-related activities. However, in its ongoing and proactive investigative efforts, OIG continues to include review of SBIR grant files and coordination with SBIR Program Managers.
